With 10 channels of bidirectional FireWire communication, eight mic/line inputs, MIDI and S/PIDIF I/O, a no-latency monitoring system with separate cue, headphone and control room outputs, two balanced inserts and a the 48-track Cubase LE software for a street price of around \$599, it is also an excellent value."
